Please note that you may access your child's First Communication, Progress Report, Report Card for Terms I and II (including the final report card) through the Mozaik Parent Portal. Please be sure to keep a copy of your child's final report card for your records.

First Communication

By October 15, 2020, the First Communication may be accessed through the Mozaik Parent Portal. Each student will be evaluated in their Learning Progress and Behavior in English Language Arts, Mathematics and French Second Language.

Progress Report

By November 20, 2020, the Progress Report may be accessed through the Mozaik Parent Portal. Each student will be evaluated in their Learning Progress and Behavior in all subjects.

Term I Report Card

The Term I report card may be accessed through the Mozaik Parent Portal by January 22, 2021. The report card will cover the period from September 1 to January 8, 2021 and will count for 50% of the student's final mark.

For Terms I and II, the teacher communicates a mark expressed as a percentage that reflects the knowledge and subject-specific competencies that a student has acquired, based on the evaluations carried out during the term (tests, assignments, etc.).

Term II Report Card

The Term II report card may be accessed through the Mozaik Parent Portal by July 10, 2021. The report card will cover the period from January 11, 2021 until the end of the school year. The teacher will also include in the evaluation the student's learning as a whole for the year (knowledge and subject-specific competencies). This evaluation counts for 50% of the student's final mark.
