First Communication

The first communication will be available on the Mozaik Parent Portal by October 13, 2023. Each student will be evaluated in their Learning Progress and Behavior in English Language Arts, Mathematics and French Second Language.

Term 1 Report Card

This second communication will be available on the Mozaik Parent Portal by November 17, 2023. The report card will cover the period from August 31, 2023 to November 3, 2023 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

For Terms I and II, the teacher communicates a mark expressed as a percentage that reflects the knowledge and subject-specific competencies that a student has acquired, based on the evaluations carried out during the term (tests, assignments, etc.).

Term 2 Report Card

This third communication will be available on the Mozaik Parent Portal by February 28, 2024. The report card will cover the period between November 6, 2023 and February 9, 2024 and will count for 20% of the student's final mark.

Term 3 Report Card

This fourth communication will be available on the Mozaik Parent Portal by July 10, 2024. The report card will cover the period from February 13, 2024 until the end of the year. The teacher will also include in the evaluation the student's learning as a whole for the year (knowledge and subject-specific competencies). This evaluation counts for 60% of the student's final mark.
