Registrations for new students will begin the week of **January 22 to February 29**, **2024**. Parents must call their **ZONED** school to make an appointment for registration. It is important that you have all required documents with you at the time of registration. If you have a child that will be starting school, please contact Pina Catalfamo at (450) 680-3050 ext: 7815 to make an appointment for registration.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS



- The child's original (long version) birth certificate bearing names of both parents;
- Original birth certificate or valid passport of the parent who qualifies the child eligible for English school;
- The permanent code or eligibility certificate of the parent.
- Two proofs of residence such as a municipal tax bill or utility bill;
- Both parents' social insurance number;
- Child's vaccination booklet.

To Register for Pre-Kindergarten:

your child must be 4 years of age by September 30.

To Register for Kindergarten:

your child must be 5 years of age by September 30.

To Register for any other Grade Level:

we require a copy of your child's last report card.


