Proper Use of Drop-Off Areas

It's important to be familiar with the location of your school's drop-off areas and where they are located in relation to designated entrances and exits. If the drop-off area is occupied, wait for a space to become available instead of double parking or parking in an unauthorized spot to drop off your child.

A new sign has been placed on rue de Lourdes along the side of the preschool yard fence to indicate where you can now park for 15 minutes to drop off your child to school, (see picture). Kindly respect the signage and designated areas where you can park your car.

The front of the school is a designated BUS Zone for the school busses. There is no parking in the BUS Zone.

SCHOOL FEES

The school fee invoice is now available on the Mozaik Parent Portal.

Payment is due November 1, 2023

Payments may be made online. Refer to the online payment procedure below.

Payment may also be made by credit card by calling the school secretary at (450) 680-3050 ext. 7815.

Procedures on How to Make Online Payments

- Your invoice and statement of account will include an individual reference number just under the summary of amounts to pay.
- The reference number consists of 19 numeric and alphanumeric digits beginning with the letters **ES**.
- Each parent will be given a unique reference number and *must* use this number when paying online in order to have the payment applied correctly.
- Receipts and government tax slips, such as relevé 24, arts or fitness receipts, will be issued to the individual who makes the payment.
- When you log on your bank's online payment feature, you will need to add **Sir-Wilfrid-Laurier School Board – Schools/Student Fees** as a payee.
- When setting up your payee, you will enter your unique reference number starting with the letters **ES**.
- *Do not enter any spaces.*
- Reference numbers are different for each child. Parents must make separate payments for each individual child.
- Please note that it will take 3 to 5 business days for payments to be processed through your bank.

DISMISSALS

All absences, late arrivals or early dismissals, parents are required to notify the school through the Mozaik Parent Portal.

Any early dismissals, parents are also required to advise the teacher.
